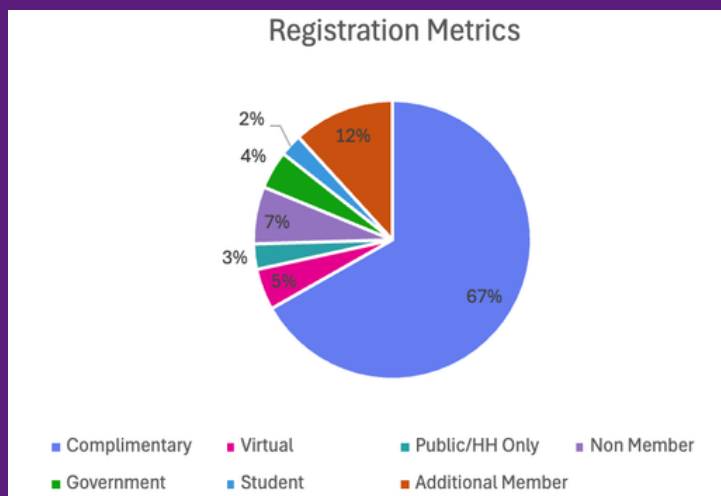


VOSS VI (2025) Metrics and Stats

Throughout the four-day event, held from September 08-11, 2025, Space ISAC convened the global space community for hands-on workshops, Tabletop Exercises, Space Break Out Sessions, and dynamic panels, keynotes, and fireside chats. The Summit was a powerful showcase of collaboration and innovation, sparking thought-provoking discussions that advanced the global dialogue on space security. With representation from across the United States and international participants from Australia, Canada, Germany, Israel, Japan, Spain, United Kingdom, and beyond, the event underscored the truly global nature of the Space ISAC community.

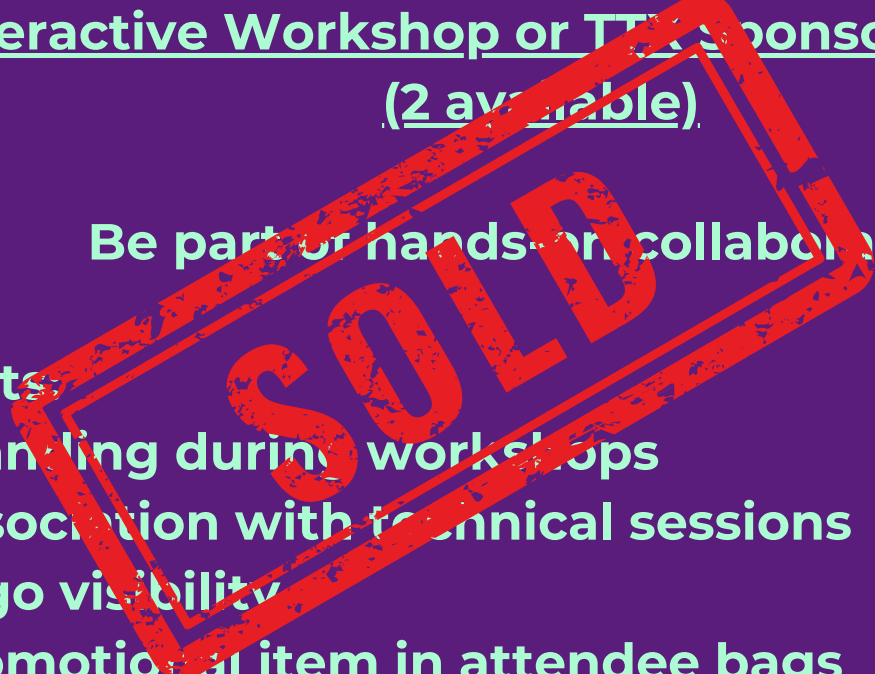
