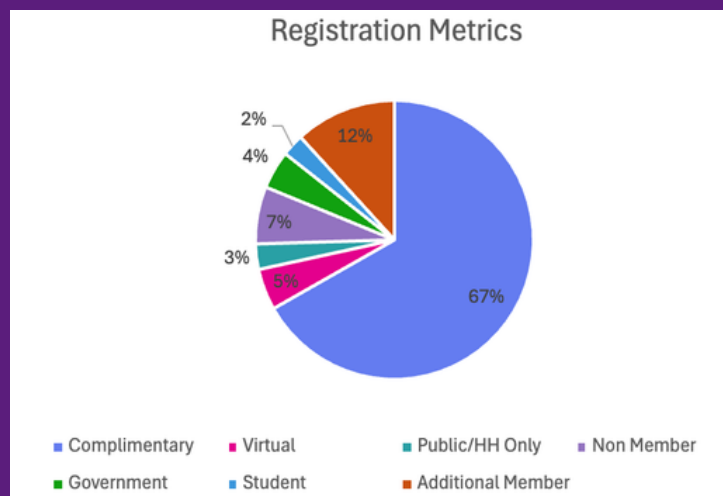


## VOSS VI (2025) Metrics and Stats

Serving as a cornerstone for partnership and progress, the 2025 Value of Space Summit (VOSS VI) fostered connections among Space ISAC members, government partners, industry experts, and academic leaders dedicated to securing the future of space. Throughout the four-day event, held from September 08-11, 2025, Space ISAC convened the global space community for hands on workshops, Tabletop Exercises, Space Break Out Sessions, and dynamic panels, keynotes, and fireside chats. The Summit was a powerful showcase of collaboration and innovation, sparking thought-provoking discussions that advanced the global dialogue on space security. With representation from across the United States and international participants from the Australia, Canada, Germany, Israel, Japan, Spain, United Kingdom, and beyond, the event underscored the truly global nature of the Space ISAC community.
